Main water issues

- Water shortage
- Pollution of surface and groundwater resources
- River flows reduction
- Poor infrastructure
- Legal and institutional deficiency
- Inadequate monitoring
- Inadequate human capacity
- Lack of harmonized classification scheme
- Deterioration/decreasing water quality
- Degradation of ecosystem



South Caucasus Cases

- **Creation of Enabling Environment for Integrated Management of the Kura-Aras Transboundary River Basin**

- **Assessment of Water Resources and water related ecosystems**

Steps towards the implementation of EU FWD

- Development of National Strategy for Azerbaijan and Georgia in line with EU WFD, identification of water use functions in transboundary watersheds, ratification of international water agreements;
- Harmonization of the methodology for hydro-geological zoning and revitalizing the groundwater quantity and quality monitoring.
- Establishment common monitoring indicators, development of regional information system for the countries, development of early warning system.
- Establishment of investment programs for improved irrigation infrastructure, reconstruction of waste water treatment facilities
- Improved coordination between agencies which deal with water resources
- Public Private adaptation measures to prepare future water shortages due to climate change.
- introduction of the principles of the Urban Wastewater Treatment Directive in the major agglomerations;
