Consultative group in the Luan river basin (China)

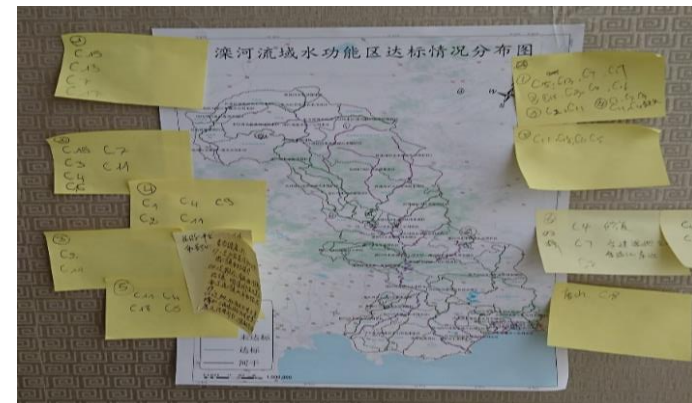
2 pilot river basins : the Luan and the Zhou

Consultation meetings throughout each important steps of basin management planning:

Diagnosis and state of water resources & aquatic ecosystems

Programs of measures and plans

Following up and monitoring on the implementation of the measures



European Union Water Initiative Plus (EUWI+)

6 countries: Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova, Ukraine - 8 pilot basins

3 countries have basin committees

Workshop on participatory management
(with NGOs, local authorities)

2 consultation phases: 2019 et 2020

Dissemination and accessibility of information

Awareness actions (young people and rural populations). Awareness campaign carried out in Armenia with schoolchildren (2 basins, 30 schools, around 350 children).



Training of teachers to conduct an awareness campaign on water quality with their students (June 2019)

Hydrographic regions

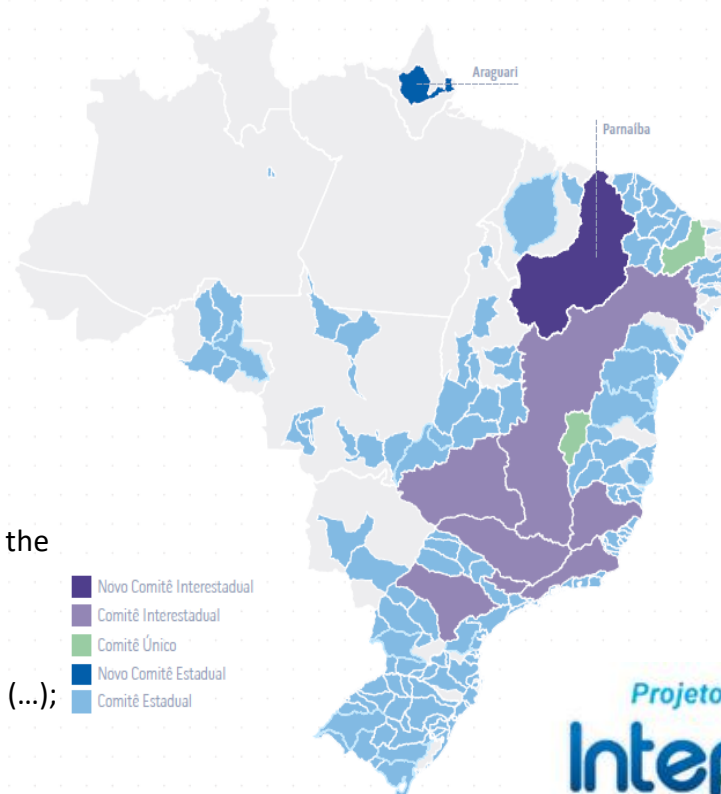
Water Law of January 8, 1997 which establishes the national water resources policy

Art.1 ° The national water resources policy is based on the following fundamental principles:

...

V - The hydrographic basin is the territorial unit for the implementation of the national water resources policy (...);

VI - The management of water resources must be decentralized and rely on the **participation of the public authorities, users and communities.**

233 hydrographic basin committees (committees of river basins at Federal level or at the level of federated states).



Participatory Management at hydrographic basin level in Burkina Faso

- **The creation of the 5 Water Agencies, emblems of IWRM in Burkina Faso**

A process marked since 1999 by the participatory approach: these agencies are in charge of the planning and concerted management of water by hydrographic basin.

- **Bodies associated to the Water Agencies**

1. The basin committee

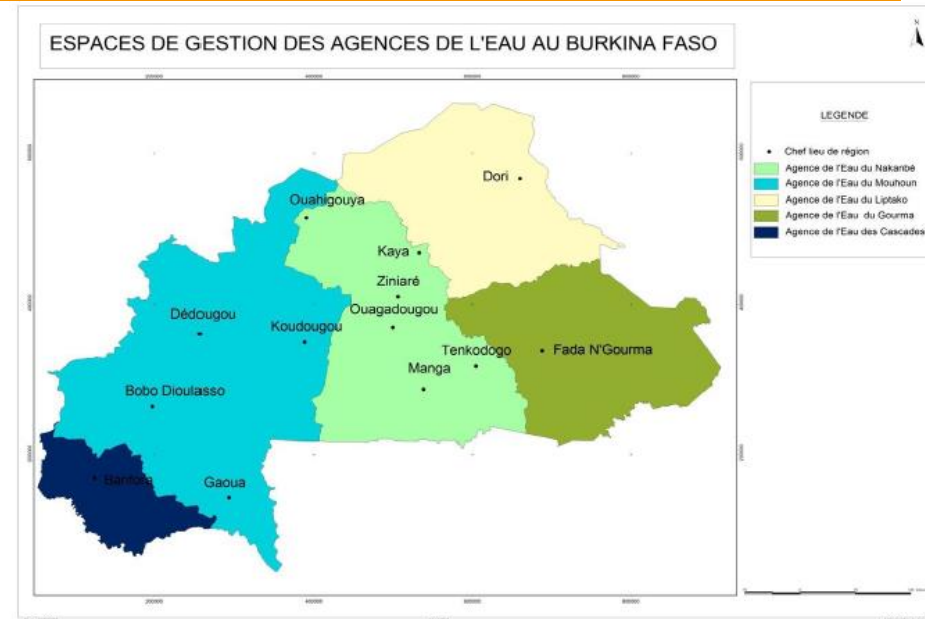
General assembly of actors in charge of the implementation of basin management plans (SDAGE / SAGE)

2. The board

Executive body of the basin committee, in charge of implementing the orientations determined by the basin committee in the multi-annual intervention programmes

3. Les Local Water Committees

Association of water users and local stakeholders in charge of field actions



- **The Financial Contribution for Water (CFE)**

This tax aims to promote self-financing of protective actions, restoration, preservation and management of water resources. It makes the user a major player in the national effort of resource preservation.
