






Sweden's five water districts


- Sweden is divided into five river basin water districts.
- The 21 County Administrative Boards are responsible for realizing the WFD in Sweden
- One County Administrative Board in each district is appointed River Basin Water District Authority.
- The River Basin Water District Authority coordinate the work within each district and ratifies the Program of Measures and the River Basin Management Plan.


