The Africa Water Vision 2025



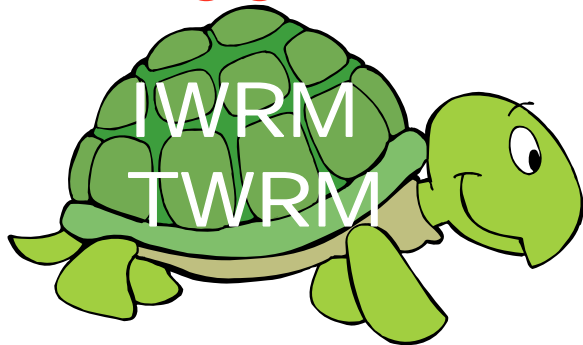
“An Africa where there is an equitable and sustainable use and management of water resources for poverty alleviation, socio-economic development, regional cooperation, and the environment.”

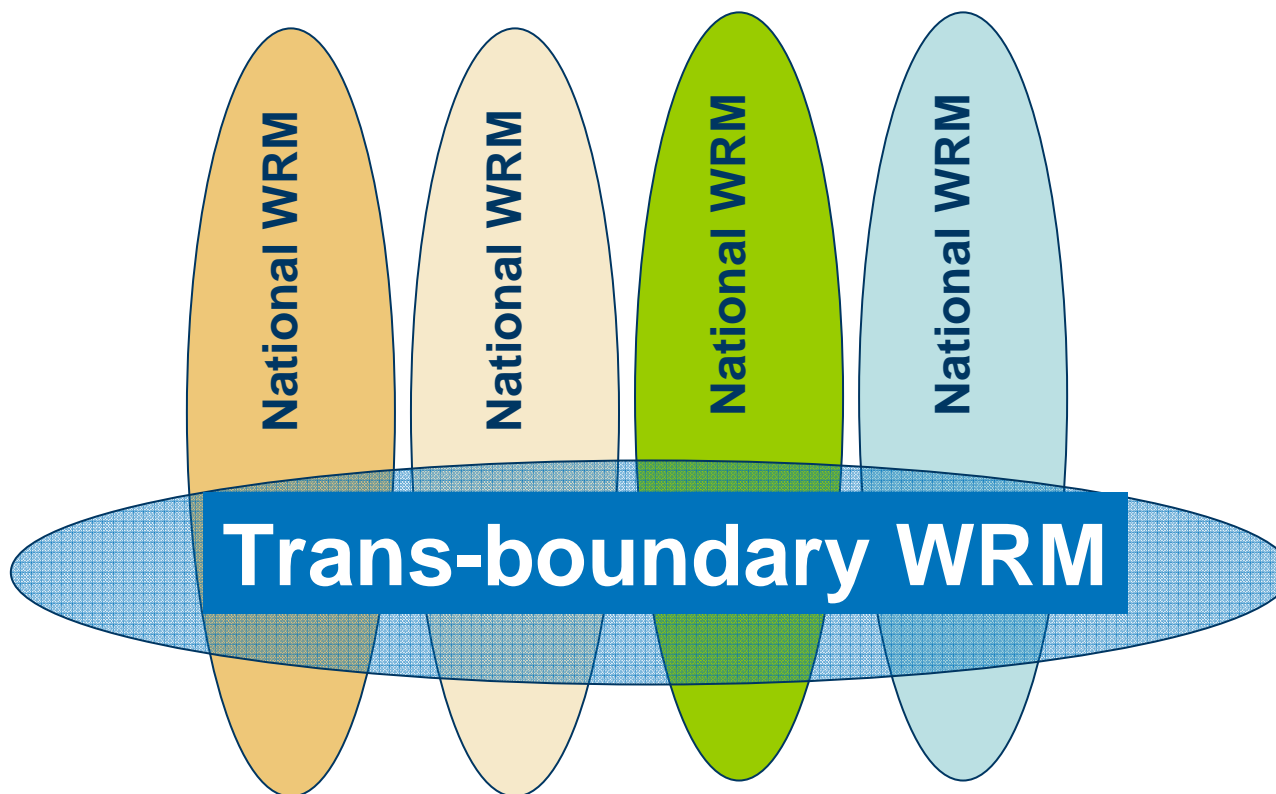
WHAT HAVE WE LEARNED?

- The Water Police (i.e. The WRM Authority) plays a cardinal role in practical **IWRM at national level**
- In order to have any impact on water resource development, the Water Police needs to have:
 - A broad and strong political will and backing
 - Appropriate knowledge and capacity (**hydrology**)
 - Public recognition and respect
 - A determination to perform its regulatory role, **especially effective water licensing**



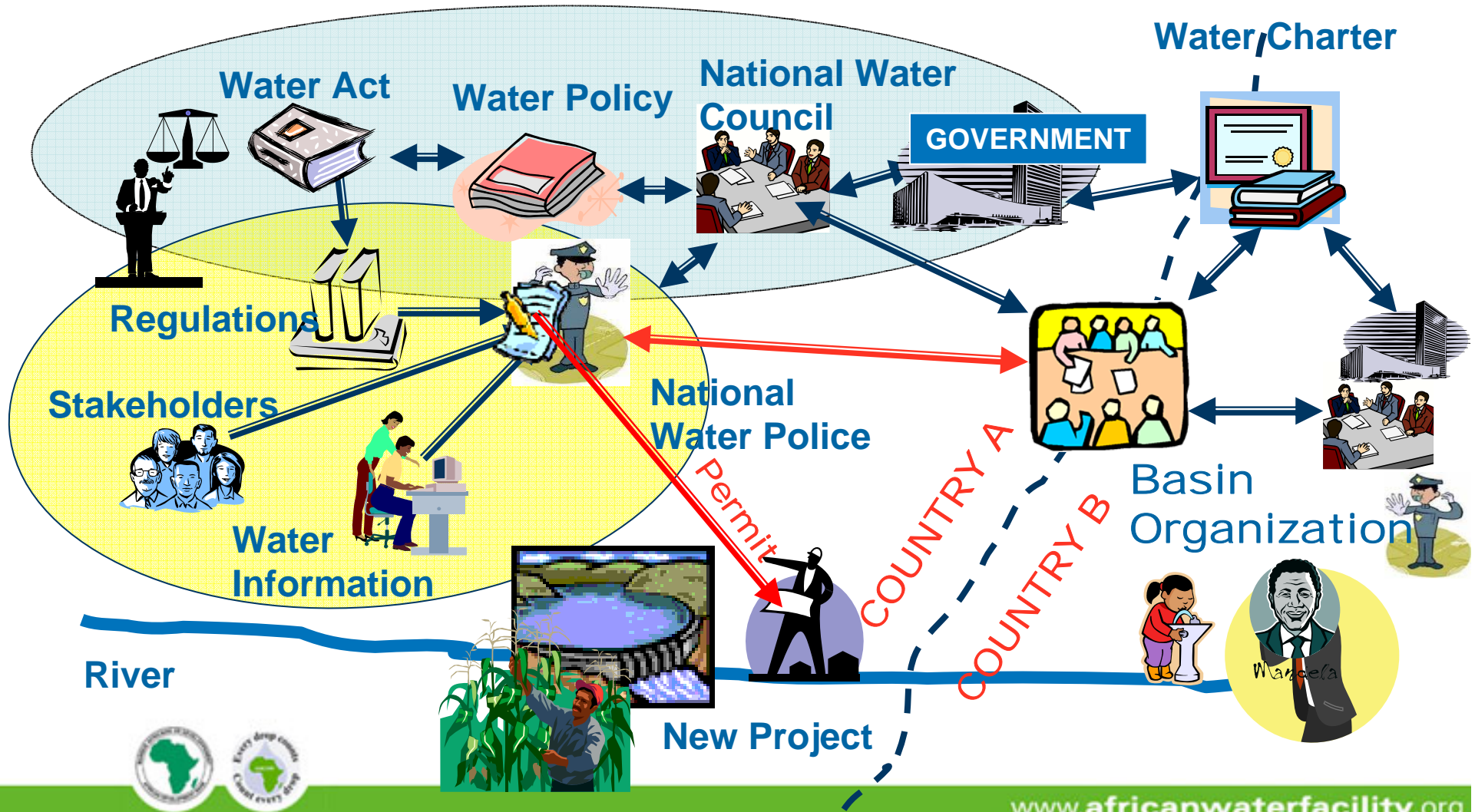


National and Trans-boundary WRM

SUMMARY



- **TWRM (“macro management”) closely linked to national IWRM reforms (“micro management”)**
- **Strengthen national hydrological services and secure funding**
- **National IWRM Authority to be more accountable for water resources licensing (policing)**
- **Pursue TWRM legal and political enabling environment – “Water Charters”**
- **BOs to be more in the driver’s seat for studies and basin interventions**
- **Promote joint water development investments for socio-economic development and prosperity**
