





Paris Pact on water and adaptation to climate change in the basins of rivers, lakes and aquifers

We, representatives of governments, international organizations, donors, national and transboundary basin organizations of rivers, lakes or aquifers, local authorities, of the civil society and companies, support the integration of fresh water into the Global Climate Action Agenda, especially for initiating or strengthening necessary adaptation actions in the basins of rivers, lakes, aquifers, large wetlands as well as coastal areas.

GENERAL STATEMENT

Climate change is already affecting and will increasingly affect the quantity and quality of freshwater and aquatic ecosystems, especially through the intensity and greater frequency of extreme hydrological events, such as floods and droughts, as well as the increase in ocean level, which

We should act quickly before it is too late!

To that end, mobilizing new and increasing funding dedicated to climate change adaptation in basins is essential. Therefore, new basin organizations and existing ones should be financed and strengthened to facilitate the cooperation, coordination and exchange of information, dialogue, consultation and prevention of conflicts between stakeholders and to enhance the implementation of adaptation measures and the sharing of benefits on the basin scale,

We encourage donors to support prior assessments and actions for adaptation to climate change in basins,

Local authorities and communities, economic sectors and the civil society should be better associated and involved in basin management, including in the definition and implementation of adaptation measures.

Cooperation and exchange should increase between the institutions involved, especially among the basin organizations at the global and regional levels in order to facilitate the transfer of experience and know-how on best practices in basin management and adaptation to climate change.


We recognize that adaptation actions should be undertaken without delay to minimize the impacts of climate change on the populations' health and safety, on economic development and the environment, considering the importance of the protection of water-related ecosystems.

The basins are natural areas where water flows on the surface and in the subsoil: they are the relevant territories for organizing water resources management.

In order to ensure more effectiveness, these actions to adapt to climate change should thus be implemented at the level of river, lake and aquifer basins, through a joint, participative, integrated and sustainable water resources management.

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS:

1) Reinforce capacity development and knowledge,

Establish risk warning and water information systems in a context of uncertainty.

2) Adapt basin management planning to climate change,

Better controlling water demand and developing a more efficient and sustainable use of water resources (including groundwater) - Enhance the services of water-related ecosystems

3) Reinforce governance,

Create new basin organizations and reinforce existing ones

Support mechanisms for the involvement of the stakeholders in basin management,

4) Ensure adequate financing.



The Thematic Structure – at a glance









La lettre du RIOB

De la parole aux actes : Il faut agir vite, avant qu'il ne soit trop tard !

Le constat est alarmant : inondations, sécheresses, cyclones, pluies, maladies hydriques, pollution, gélifications, érosion, destruction des écosystèmes... la gravité de la situation dans beaucoup de pays nécessite la mise en œuvre rapide d'une gestion globale, intégrée et cohérente des ressources en eau.

Le changement climatique aggrave ces situations et il affecte d'ores et déjà et de plus en plus, la quantité et la qualité de l'eau douce continentale et les écosystèmes aquatiques.

Le régime de tous nos fleuves et le niveau de nos aquifères seront sensiblement modifiés ! Tout cela représente une menace pour la sécurité, la santé, le développement économique et social et pour l'environnement, en particulier dans les pays les plus pauvres.

Une mobilisation est indispensable au niveau mondial, afin de mettre en place, de façon urgente, les programmes pour atténuer les pressions et prévenir les effets du réchauffement global et s'y adapter.

The findings are alarming: Floods, droughts, cyclones, scarcity, waterborne diseases, pollution, waste, erosion, destruction of ecosystems, the seriousness of the situation in many countries requires the quick implementation of comprehensive, integrated and consistent water resources management.

Climate change is exacerbating these situations and is affecting more and more the quantity and quality of inland freshwater and aquatic ecosystems.

The regime of all our rivers and the level of our aquifers will be substantially modified!

All this represents a threat to security, economic and social development and the environment, especially in the poorest countries.

Mobilization is essential at all levels to urgently set up programs that are needed to mitigate pressures and prevent and adapt to the effects of global warming.

Quick action would reduce costs and damage, we should worry about the "cost of inaction"?

Freshwater is one of the first victims of climate change: **we must act quickly, before it is too late.**

The problems encountered are not technical, but mainly institutional and financial.

We must get mobilized to win this water battle and prepare the future of next generations.

Everything is still possible. Let's act quickly!





